The Proof Mark: Our Sanctification

1 Thessalonians 4:1-11

Therefore ...

- “This is the first time a civilization has existed that, to a significant extent, does not believe in objective right and wrong.”
- “A spiritual bridge always involves a physical reality. People need to see to believe.”
- “Without practical, attractive, spiritually compelling, proof positive lifestyles, what good are our claims and pronouncements about a life changing God?”
- Therefore: “It is God’s will that you be sanctified wholly...” I Thess. 4:4; 5:25

Having Started Your Sanctification...

- ...we ask you and urge you in Jesus, to do this more and more. It is even more critical in our dark day. 4:2
- “It is God’s will that you be sanctified” 4:3 That you are a “living sacrifice.” Rom.12:1
- It is God himself – a God of deliberate powerful peace – who will “sanctify you through and through” by faith. 5:23-24

God by the Holy Spirit

- **Will sanctify us and will keep us blameless in:**
 - **Spirit – brotherly love**
 - **Soul – kept blameless by our faithful God**
 - **Body – keeping us from sexual immorality**
 - **Teaching us to control our own body**
 - **Keeping us from wronging another or taking advantage**
- **The expectation is Sanctification for ALL disciples in ALL aspects of life including our sexuality.**
- **For we are not to be impure (idolatry of sex, exaltation of self, identity by forms of lust) but are to live a holy life.**

- The lifestyle is that of honesty, minding one's own business. Ethical principles and clear standards mark our style.
- We work with our hands and are worthy of trust.
- Our daily life expresses our character. We have a sense of purposefulness, and energy as we see the possibilities in life.
- We win respect for we follow through and have a confidence that is not arrogant. For we are also teachable and enlist help.

We are not Dependent

- **Having a clear sense of who we are we are cheerfully interdependent.**
 - **We are comfortable in our own skin.**
 - **We are confident our past sins have been forgiven and no longer determine my identity.**
 - **We are at peace with our strengths and weaknesses, our gifts and graces.**
 - **We are confident that the assignment of life in which I find myself is under the sovereign knowledge and will of my God period!**
